ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The Internet access of Bloom Township High School District 206 is to be used in a responsible, efficient, ethical and legal manner in accordance with the mission of the District. Users must acknowledge their understanding of this policy and attached rules as a condition of receiving an Internet account. Failure to adhere to the policy and rules may result in suspending or revoking the offender's privilege of access and other disciplinary action as appropriate.

ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY RULES

Internet access is now available to students and employees in Bloom Township High School District 206. District 206 is very pleased to bring this access to students and employees. Our goal is to promote educational excellence in the District 206 schools by facilitating resource sharing, innovation, and communication.

The Internet is an electronic highway connecting thousands of computers all over the world and millions of individual subscribers. Through the Internet connection, students and employees have access to electronic mail communication with people all over the world.

Having access to computers and people all over the world brings the availability of material that may not be considered of educational value in the context of the school setting. District 206 has taken available precautions, using a software program to restrict access to some locations. A qualified staff member will supervise students while they are using Internet resources. District 206 will rely on staff supervision to control access. However, on a global network it is impossible to control all materials, and an industrious user may discover controversial information. District 206 firmly believes that the valuable information and interaction available on this worldwide network far outweigh the possibility that users may procure material that is not consistent with the educational goals of District 206.

Internet access is coordinated through a complex association of government agencies, state, regional and local networks. In addition, the smooth operation of the network relies upon the proper conduct of the end users who must adhere to strict guidelines. These guidelines are provided here so that users are aware of the responsibilities they are about to acquire. In general, this requires efficient, ethical and legal utilization of the network resources. If a District 206 user violates any of these provisions, his or her account will be terminated, future access may be denied, and disciplinary action will result.
